### **Timetable:**

Set-up: Artist and models are requested to be on site at 8:30 to set up.

### **Competition:**

Competition start time is 9am through until 4pm with a mandatory one hour break for lunch.

### **Photography and Judging:**

On completion of painting time, models and artists need to proceed to the on-site studio for their entries to be photographed and judged. If you finish before the allotted time, you may go to the studio earlier.

All artist and models must have signed the release form to allow images to be used for promotional purposes of future Bodycraft events. A copy of all images will be made available.

### **Presentation:**

Catwalk presentation of all entries will begin at 5pm

### **Results:**

Results will be announced straight after the presentation

### **Prizes:**

Prizes will be awarded for first place and runner up.

### **A few necessities:**

This competition is mixed technique; Brush and Sponge, Airbrush and prosthetics can be used.

Model genitalia (and nipples for females) must be covered. All types of cover are allowed, for model comfort, please check with your model prior to the event as to their cover preference.

Only products designed for use on the skin to be used.

### **The following is a list of THINGS ALLOWED:**

False Fingernails

False Eyelashes

Contact lenses

Texture Stencils

Glitter

Decorative headpieces / Wigs.

Prosthetics and accessories.

### **Here are a few things NOT ALLOWED:**

This is pretty much an anything goes category, but is a solo competitions, no assistants. Large prosthetics (cowls, full face masks, large area coverage) must be painted in competition time. Smaller accessories can be pre-painted.
